

Ferrellgas supports local math students

For the past three years, Fannie Bush Elementary had been using VMath, created by Voyager Learning, as a research-based intervention program for students in grades 2-5 who were performing below grade level.

Due to budget constraints, the funds for continuation were not available for the current year. The school had seen great gains in math with the support of the program.

Students use Everyday Math as the adopted math curriculum along with Everyday Counts for calendar math, Arithmetic Developed Daily as review, flexible grouping, and several interventions, including VMath.

Ferrellgas of Winchester and Angie Taylor, principal of Fannie Bush E teamed together to continue the support of the VMath program.

The school has and continues to make Annual Yearly Progress as required by No Child Left Behind. Their current transitional index in math is 94.47.
